Discussion:

- 1. Dwayne discussed the large amounts of ongoing events for the end of the year.
- 2. The new ramps will be installed for graduation. Normally they are rented from another school district.
- 3. A new camera system will be installed to have live coverage of sporting events going on within the campus. The Pixellot system is an unmanned single fixed rig with multiple cameras that can cover an entire field.
- 4. Four State Playoffs were hosted at the school district and four more were scheduled for June 6th. A fire was happening on Old Berwick Road during one playoff game. The staff was able to notify fans from Montoursville to exit by 84 Lumber and take Route 11 home with no issues.

- 7. Doug asked if there is a guideline for the time it should take students to evacuate a building. Christina said she would check with PSBA for recommendations.
- 8. Jim reviewed all workplace incidents that happened with staff members. Everything was evaluated and the proper follow ups will happen.
